(29) To the sale, grant and deed of a certain lot of ground and the improvements thereon, in the town of Queen Anne, in the Sixth Election District of Queen Anne's County, on the southwest corner of Broad Street and Tuckahoe Avenue, in said town, having a frontage on Broad Street of sixty feet and a depth of one hundred and sixty feet along Tuckahoe Avenue, to "St. Paul Methodist Episcopal Church South, Queen Anne, Maryland, a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Maryland, by Thomas B. Spranklin, D. H. Knott, J. L. Beauchamp and Harry Clark, surviving trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church South, by their deed dated the 22nd day of September, 1913, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said Queen Anne's County, in Liber WFW 4, folio 170, a land record book for Queen Anne's County, and that fee-simple title vest absolutely in said corporation, its successors and assigns to its own and their own use and behoof.
