(62) To the deed, sale, grant and conveyance in a deed from Anna M. Weilbrenner and Peter Weinbrenner, her husband, to the Russian Congregation B'nai Israel of Baltimore City of the lot of ground situate in Baltimore County, and more particularly described in said deed to the Russian Congregation B'nai Israel of Baltimore City, dated the 13th day of April, 1910, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber WPC No. 360, folio 109, etc.

(63) To the following bequests and devises contained in the last will and testament of George Gunther, late of Baltimore City, deceased, dated May 23rd, 1911, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Baltimore City in Wills Liber HWJ No. 113, folio 485, etc.; (a) To the General German Orphan Association of Baltimore City, the sum of one hundred dollars; (b) to the Saint Anthony's Orphan Asylum of Baltimore City, located at Nos. 925 to 941 North Central Avenue, Baltimore City, the sum of five hundred dollars; (c) to the Saint Joseph's Hospital and Free Dispensary of Baltimore City, located at the corner of Caroline and Hoffman Streets, Baltimore City, the sum of four hundred dollars; (d) to the German Society of Maryland, the sum of one hundred dollars.

(64) To the deed, sale, grant and conveyance from Esther J. Davis to the Liberty Heights Avenue Baptist Society of Balti-
