

(1) To the one-half of the residue of her estate to the Metropolitan Presbyterian Church of Washington, D. C., to be devoted by it to the benefit of the poor of the Church.

(2) To the remaining one-half of the residue unto the George Washington University of said city to be used for the purposes of the free wards of its University Hospital, said residue consisting of property located mostly in Maryland.

76. To a certain deed from George E. Cooper to the Collett Memorial African Methodist Episcopal Church for a lot of ground in Baltimore City, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining thereon a church or meeting house, with full power to said Vestry of holding, selling, leasing, mortgaging, assigning, conveying or disposing of any and all property acquired under the provision of this Act.

77. To the bequest of \$200.00, contained in the last Will and Testament of Mrs. Mary Horn, late of Carroll County, deceased, unto the Brethren Church of Linwood, Carroll County, in the State of Maryland.

78. To the bequests contained in the last Will and Testament of Martha H. Leiter, viz.: (a) to St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Leitersburg, one hundred dollars; (b) to St. James' Reformed Church of Leitersburg, one hundred dollars, and (c) to the Trustees or proper legal governing body of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in trust, two hundred dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT for the protection of life and property from loss through escaping gas.

CHAPTER 857.

AN ACT providing for the selection and the purchase of a site and for the construction of a high school building and the furnishing of a heating apparatus and equipment therefor to
