- SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That the expenses incurred under the provisions of this Act, shall be paid in the same manner as the ordinary expenses for the support of schools in the several Counties of the State.
- SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts in conflict with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed in so far as they are in conflict herewith.
- SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1st, 1914.

CHAPTER 166.

An Act to repeal Section 49 of Chapter 731 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1912, entitled "An Act to revise the Child Labor Laws' of this State by repealing Section 4 of Article 100 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Work, Hours of, in Factories," as repealed and re-enacted with amendments by Chapter 192 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland for 1906, and by repealing Sections 5 to 12, both inclusive of said Article 100 as enacted by Chapter 192 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland for 1906 and by repealing Section 4 of said Chapter 192 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland for 1906, and by enacting in lieu of said Section so repealed 47 new Sections of said Article 100, to be known as Sections 4 to 50, both inclusive, of said Article 100, title "Work, Hours of, in Factories," sub-title "Employment of Minors," said new Sections so enacted providing regulations for the employment of minors, establishing a system of employment certificates, providing for enforcement of said regulations and appropriating money therefore and to re-enact said Section 49 with amendments.
