SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 222.

An Act to authorize the Governor to appoint two hundred (200) additional notaries public for Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and with the advice and consent of the Senate is hereby authorized to appoint two hundred additional notaries public for Baltimore City in addition to the number now authorized by law, of whom not more than sixty may be females.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 223.

An Act to add a new Section to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," sub-title "Registrations," said new Section to be known as Section 29-A, and to immediately follow Section 29 in said Article, and to apply only to Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new Section be added to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," sub-title "Registrations," said new Section to be known as Section 29-A and to immediately follow Section 29 in said Article and to read as follows:

29-A. Declarations of Intention mentioned in the preceding Section may as an alternative method of making said Declarations be made before the Board of Registry when in session of
