to the inhabitants of Easton and vicinity the products of the several utilities under its control and management.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 97-BB of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Easton," as passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at the January session of 1906, Chapter 458, as amended by Chapter 440 of the Acts of 1908, be and the same is hereby repealed.
