day of November, or upon any Sunday or election day or when the ground is covered with snow.

- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That Section 14 of Article 99 of the Code of Public General Laws, in so far as the same applies to Charles County be and the same is hereby repealed.
- SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
