one assistant clerk at a salary of Eighteen hundred (\$1,800) dollars and one deputy assistant clerk at a salary of Fifteen hundred (\$1,500) dollars per annum. The said clerks, and in the City of Baltimore the chief clerk, deputy clerk, assistant clerk, and deputy assistant clerk, shall be appointed by the respective boards of supervisors, and shall be removable by them in their discretion. In Baltimore City, the chief clerk, deputy clerk, assistant clerk, and deputy assistant clerk, with the approval of the Supervisors, shall from time to time, secure such temporary assistance as may be necessary for the proper transaction of the business of the office, but the compensation of such assistants to be paid by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, upon requisition by the said Supervisors, shall not exceed the sum of Two thousand (\$2,000) dollars in any one year.

SEC. 2. Be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 393.

An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 12 and 13 of Article 75 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Pleadings, Practice and Process at Law," subtitle "Pleadings," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 12 and 13 of Article 75 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Pleadings, Practice and Process at Law," sub-title "Pleadings" be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

12. In any suit ex contractu or upon any judgment, if the defendant shall have any demand or claim arising ex contractu or upon judgment against the plaintiff, the defendant may plead such claim specially, whether such claim of the defendant be for liquidated or unliquidated damages, and whether it be of such
