SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 428.

An Acr to appropriate a sum of money to defray the expense incurred in the publication of the Governor's proclamation setting forth the provisions of the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the State which were authorized to be submitted to the voters at the election of 1913, said publication being required by the Constitution of the State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of Maryland for the following sums in payment of said publication, and the sum of twenty thousand six hundred and twenty-three dollars and ten cents (\$20,623.10) is hereby appropriated from any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated for the payment of said sums:
