

prior to the passage of this Act exist, nor any right or rights, privilege or privileges, growing out of or incident to the same, but all such rights, privileges, shall remain unimpaired and may be enforced against the County Commissioners to the same extent as they could have been enforced against the Highways Commission of Baltimore County; and all actions or rights of action, contracts, rights or privileges, which have accrued or might or could accrue to the said Highways Commission of Baltimore County prior to the passage of this Act, shall be vested in the County Commissioners of Baltimore County, and all new actions instituted in connection therewith shall be in the name of the County Commissioners of Baltimore County, and all existing actions to which the Highways Commission of Baltimore County may be a party may be amended by making the County Commissioners of Baltimore County a party in the place and stead of said Highways Commission.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That when the word or words or descriptive phrase "Board," "Commissioners" or "County Commissioners" are used in this Act such phrase, word or words shall be construed and taken to mean and refer to the Board of County Commissioners of Baltimore County.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That all Acts and parts of Acts, laws and parts of laws, inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Places of Reformation and Punishment," sub-head "State Penitentiary" and all Sections under said sub-head "State Penitentiary" as the same now stand;
