

WHEREAS, By reason of said accident caused through the lack of sufficient and proper help by the State, the said Harry P. McCormick was forced to expend the sum of three hundred and seventy-six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$376.75) for operation and medical treatment; and

WHEREAS, The said injuries complained of were cause entirely through the lack of competent and proper help in the said State Tobacco Warehouse, in Baltimore City, and through no fault of the said Harry P. McCormick; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer of Maryland is hereby empowered and directed to pay out of any funds in the Treasury of this State, not otherwise specifically appropriated, to Harry P. McCormick, of Baltimore City, a sum of three hundred and seventy-six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$376.75) to repay and reimburse him for the actual hospital expenses and medical attention which he was forced to pay by reason of an accident which occurred in the said State Tobacco Warehouse, of Baltimore City, on or about August 12th, 1912.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
