

the Board of School Commissioners of Howard County, the County Treasurer and Collector of Howard County, the County Surveyor and Engineer of Howard County, and the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Howard County, in all matters of a legal nature requiring the services of an attorney-at-law. The said Attorney shall advise said Board by his opinion on all legal matters referred to him by any of said Boards or individuals, and said attorney shall also appear in Court and defend all suits brought by or against any of said Boards or individuals acting in his, their or its official capacity.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That all special counsel acting and existing for said Boards or individuals mentioned in Section 1 of this Act and whose compensation is paid or provided for either directly or indirectly by the County Commissioners of Howard County, be, and the said office of counsel or attorney is hereby abolished.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this Act, whether of a general or special nature, be, and the same are hereby repealed, to the extent only of such inconsistency.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from June 1st, 1916.

CHAPTER 593.

AN ACT to regulate the manufacture, purchase, sale or dealing in medicinal, pharmaceutical, scientific, sacramental, mechanical, culinary or toilet preparations.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be unlawful to manufacture, buy, sell
