State Treasurer in favor of George Keck and Peter J. Campbell, Receivers of The Golden Gate Company of Baltimore City for the sum of forty-six dollars and seven cents, being onefourth of the proportionate part of the money paid by the said Golden Gate Company of Baltimore City for said license and received by the Treasurer of Maryland, and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City are hereby authorized and directed to refund and pay to the said George Keck and Peter J. Campbell, Receivers of the Golden Gate Company of Baltimore City, the sum of one hundred and thirty-eight dollars and eighteen cents, being three-fourths or the proportionate part paid by the said Golden Gate Company of Baltimore City and received by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City, being a due proportion of said license fee for a period during which said license was not used, to wit: two months and seven days.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the first day of June, 1916.
