

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of Six Thousand One Hundred and Ninety-five (\$6,195) Dollars be and the same hereby is appropriated to pay the judgments rendered by the Circuit Court for Calvert County, at the January, 1916, term of said Court, in the proceedings there instituted, under the Article and Section above mentioned, for the condemnation of the areas or lots under oyster leases to the parties hereinafter named, the said parties, together with the judgments rendered in favor of each, the same aggregating Six Thousand One Hundred and Ninety-five (\$6,195) Dollars, being as follows:
