

house in Galena, with all the power and discretion herein mentioned.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That William G. Smith, Morris Bramble, Dr. Frank Smith, Harry C. Willis and Jefferson L. Smyth be and they are hereby created and constituted the Fairlee Building Committee for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this Act relating to the selection of a site, and the building and equipping of said public high school house in Fairlee, with all the power and discretion herein mentioned.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That the Kent County School Board and Jefferson L. Smyth be and they are hereby created and constituted the Chestertown Building Committee for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this Act relating to the selection of a site and the building and equipping of said public school house in Chestertown for the use of colored children, with all the power and discretion herein mentioned.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the Board of County School Commissioners for Kent County are hereby authorized and directed to fill by appointment any vacancy which may occur in any of the three aforesaid Committees by death, failure to qualify, resignation or otherwise.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That immediately upon the sale of the bonds provided for by this Act, the three aforesaid Committees shall proceed to secure proper sites for their respective school houses (if the said Committees shall deem the purchase of said sites as necessary); and each of the Committees mentioned in this Act shall proceed to secure proper plans for their respective school houses; and after the securing and adoption of proper plans and specifications, which shall be left with the Superintendent of the Board of County School Commissioners for Kent County for public inspection, each of the Committees mentioned in this Act shall advertise at least once a week for four successive weeks, in two newspapers published in Kent County, Maryland, for bids for the construction of their respective school houses, and shall award their respective contracts to the lowest responsible bidder, who will enter into contract and execute a sufficient bond with approved security for the erection and completion of said public school houses, each of the said Committees, however, to have full power in their discretion to reject any and all bids, and to advertise for other bids.
