

CHECK ROOMS.

179. Each person, firm or corporation, conducting a check room in this State for the deposit of packages and baggage shall pay a privilege tax for stall purposes, and before doing so, shall first take out a license therefor, paying an annual license fee as follows:

First. Where the charge for the keep or deposit of any article is at the rate of 10 cents or more for every twenty-four hours or fraction thereof of storage, each, per annum \$ 40.00

Second. Where the charge for the keep or deposit of any article is at the rate of less than 10 cents for every twenty-four hours or fraction thereof of storage, each, per annum..... \$ 20.00

CLEANING, DYEING AND PRESSING.

180. Each person, firm or corporation, resident or non-resident conducting the business of cleaning, dyeing and pressing in this State, when done by steam, electric or other power than by hand, shall before doing so, take out a license therefor, and shall pay an annual license fee therefor as follows:

Establishments employing less than five persons....\$ 5.00

Establishments employing not less than five persons and not more than ten persons.....\$ 15.00

Establishments employing not less than ten persons and not more than twenty persons.....\$ 50.00

Establishments employing more than twenty persons.\$100.00

SHOE SHINING PARLORS AND HAT CLEANING ESTABLISHMENTS.

181. Each person, firm or corporation conducting a shoe shining parlor, containing more than two chairs, or hat cleaning establishment, shall before doing so, take out a license therefor, and shall for each place of business, pay an annual license fee of \$10.00.

RESTAURANTS OR EATING PLACES.

182. Each person, firm or corporation, resident or non-resident, operating or conducting a restaurant or eating place, shall before doing so, take out a license therefor, and shall pay an annual license fee for each place of business so operated, graduated as follows:
