

587. If either inspector neglects to discharge his duties as prescribed in this sub-division of this Article, he shall forfeit his bond and shall be removed from office by the State Board of Labor and Statistics.

588. The State Board of Labor and Statistics with the approval of the Governor, shall fill all vacancies that may occur as soon as possible.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of June, in the year one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.

CHAPTER 208.

AN ACT regulating the sale of chicory mixed with coffee, and providing a penalty.

SECTION I. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it is lawful to sell chicory mixed with coffee if it conforms to the following conditions:

1. The amount of chicory shall not exceed fifteen per centum of the mixture of coffee and chicory.
2. The package containing the mixture shall bear the words in letters of the same style and size, but not less than one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) inch high, "coffee and chicory," and may contain also the name and address of the manufacturer and distributor, a non-descriptive brand-name, and a statement of the net weight of the package contents, but no other printed matter.
3. The mixture shall contain no cereal in any form.
4. If sold in the form of a beverage in hotels or restaurants, there shall be displayed in a prominent place, in characters easily legible to the patrons, a placard bearing the words, "The coffee sold here is mixed with chicory."

SEC. II. Any person, firm or corporate body who shall violate any of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than one hundred (\$100) dollars.

SEC. III. The State Board of Health shall be charged with the enforcement of the provisions of this Act.
