21. To the Maryland Home for Friendless Colored Children, the sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1917, and the like sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1918.

22. To the Oblate Sisters of Providence for the St. Frances' Orphan Asylum, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the fiscal year 1917, and the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the fiscal year 1918.
