

e. And the dividends or income from the Bridge Company and the Water Company stocks to be paid annually for the care and upkeep of the Glade Cemetery, near Walkersville.

(11) To the sale, grant and conveyance to The First Brethren Church of Hagerstown, Maryland, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, of a deed from John W. Meyers and Carrie C.
