

more County," as enacted by Chapter 495 of the Acts of 1908, to follow Section 116 and be known as 116A and 116B, to read as follows:

116A. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm or other explosive on the roadbed of any public highway in Baltimore County, without the written permission of the County Commissioners of Baltimore County.

116B. Any person violating the provision of this Act shall be subject, upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding Ten Dollars for each offense.
