CHAP. 121.

An act to authorise Eleanor R. Contee and Philip A. L. Passed Feb. 27, Contee, guardian of Benjamin Contee, of Charles 1837. County, to introduce certain Slaves for life into this State.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Permission That Eleanor R. Contee, and Philip A. L. Contee, granted guardian of Benjamin Contee, be and they are hereby authorised to bring from the state of Virginia to this State, the following slaves for life, to wit: Polly, Harriet, Joe, Eliza and her two children, Alic, Patty and her child, Bill, John and Eliza Ann; provided, that Proviso the said Eleanor R. Contec, and Philip A. L. Contee, guardian as aforesaid, shall comply with the provisions and conditions of the act of December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter eighty-soven.

CHAPTER 120.

In act continue in force certain acts therein mentioned. Passed Feb. 28,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Acts made per That the act entitled, an act to repair the highways petual and bridges in certain parts of the city of Baltimore, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-three, chapter one hundred and eighty-five, and an act entitled, an act to continue in force said act, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-seven, chapter eighty-seven, be and the same are hereby declared to be perpetual.

CHAPTER 121.

An act to divorce Alexander Todd, of Talbot county, Passed Feb. 25, from his wife Margaret Todd.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorce That the marriage herotofore solemnized between Alexander Todd, of Talloto county, and Margaret Todd, be and the same is hareby declared to be null, and void,
