*An act to confirm an act, entitled, an act to provide for an alteration in the Constitution, so far as relates to the division of the sixth election district in Worcester county.*

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Confirmation  
That an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled, an act to provide for an alteration in the Constitution, so far as relates to the division of the sixth election district in Worcester county, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, chapter two hundred and sixty-four, be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed.

## CHAPTER 131.

*An act to make a Public Landing and Road therein mentioned.*

Passed Mar. 6,  
1837.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly, by the petition of sundry citizens of Dorchester county, in the Northwest Fork district in said county, that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a public landing at or near a place called the ship yard, on the Northwest Fork river, and a public road from thence to Wheatleysburg, in the said Northwest Fork district:—Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Commissioners to meet and determine  
That Minos Adams, Doctor Joseph Nicols, and Matthew Smith, Sen. be, and they or a majority of them are hereby appointed commissioners to meet at a place called the ship yard, on the Northwest Fork river in Dorchester county, in the present year, and examine and determine whether the public convenience
