CHAP. 21.

CHAPTER 19.

Passed Jan. 19, 1837. *An act to confirm an act, entitled, an act for the division of Baltimore and Frederick counties, and for erecting a new one by the name of Carroll, and to alter and change the Constitution of this State, so far as may be necessary to effect the same, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty five, chapter two hundred and fifty six.*

Confirmation, *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act, entitled, an act for the division of Baltimore and Frederick counties, and for erecting a new one by the name of Carroll, and to alter and change the Constitution of this State, so far as may be necessary to effect the same, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, chapter two hundred and fifty-six, be and the same is hereby confirmed.*

CHAPTER 20.

Passed Jan. 19, 1837. *An act to authorise McClintock Young, of Washington City, to bring into this State his slave William.*

Permission granted. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That McClintock Young, of Washington city, be and he is hereby authorised to bring into this State, his slave William; provided, he shall in all respects comply with the requisitions of the several acts upon the subject of slaves.*

CHAPTER 21.

Passed Jan. 20, 1837. *An act to increase the number of Trustees of Charlotte Hall School.*

Six additional trustees. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall and may be lawful for the Trustees of Charlotte Hall School, now appointed and in office according to the original act creating and organising the same, at their next quarterly meeting, after the passage of this act, or whenever thereafter they may deem expedient, to appoint six additional Trustees to said*
