

CHAP. 140. necessary and proper for the public safety and convenience.

Return proceed-ings **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That whenever said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall have altered, changed and amended said road, that they shall make return of their proceedings to the commissioners of Allegany county.

Recorded, and kept as public road **SEC. 3.** *And be it enacted,* That the said county commissioners are hereby directed and required, to place the said road so altered and amended, on the books of said county, and that it be kept in repair in the same manner that other roads in said county, are now kept in repair.

Consent required **SEC. 4.** *And be it enacted,* That the said alterations, changes and amendments in said road, shall not be made without the consent of the owner or owners of such land, through which it is proposed to pass, and all to be made without any charge to Allegany county.

CHAPTER 140.

Passed Mar. 6, 1837. *A further additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act, to alter and change the name of Elizabeth Town, in Washington county, to Hagerstown, and to Incorporate the same.*

Limits extended **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act the limits of the corporation of Hagerstown, shall be further extended and enlarged in the following manner: beginning on the West side of the Williamsport and Hagerstown Turnpike Road, one perch South of the marsh run, and running thence parallel with said run, one perch south of the margin thereof, to the East side of the Boonsboro and Hagerstown Turnpike road, thence with said road Northwardly, until it strikes the Southwestern limits of the present lines of the corporation, thence with those lines Westwardly, to the West side of the aforesaid Williamsport and Hagerstown Turnpike Road, thence with said road to the place of beginning.

Police authority extended **Sec. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That the Moderator and Commissioners of Hagerstown for the time being shall have and exercise the same power and authority over
