SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of CIAR. 148.
Maryland, That Martin Rizen. Walter Selby, and Commissioners Levi Dawson, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and open a road in Allegany county, to commence on William's Location at the most practicable point near to Lewis Davidson's, and to pass through the neighbourhood of Walter Selby and to intersect the turnpike road leading from Camberland to Hancock, at some point between Cumberland and the farm of Michael C. Sprigs.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said road shall Restrictions not be located, opened and cleared out more than sixteen feet wide, and not to pass through any pard, garden, orchard, meadow or the lands of any person or

persons without their consent.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said commis- Plot-Record sioners shall cause a plot and certificate of said road to be made out and returned to the commissioners of Allegany county, so that the road be placed on the list of public roads in said county.

SEC 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall be null cost payable and void unless the said road be located, opened, cleardout and made passable for waggons at the cost and charges of the petitioners and others, so that Allegany county shall not have to pay any part thereof.

CHAPTER 148.

An act to repeal all that part of the Constitution and Passed Mar. 6, Form of Government, as relates to the division of 1887. Washington County into eight separate Election Districts, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Additional dief Maryland.
