SEC. 4. 8nd be it enacted, That the commissioners herein authorised to be appointed, shall be entitled to receive such compensation for their services as the commissioners of Washington county may deem reasonable, not exceeding the sum of two dollars per day for every day they shall be necessarily employed in the discharge of the duties required by this act.
