## CHAPTER 155.

Passed Max. 10 An act to ascertain the allowance of the Sheriff of Anne 1836. Annual county for keeping persons in Jail, and to provide for the maintenance of debtors actually confined in vrison.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act it shall and may be lawful for the sheriff of Anne Arundel county to ask, demand and receive for keeping each prisoner in goal and finding him or her in victuals, twenty-five cents per day, and no more, to be levied and collected as heretofore, any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.

l dollar 75 cents per week for debtors contrary notwithstanding.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That in lieu of the sum of eighty-seven and a half cents per week, which the said sheriff is now entitled to receive for the support and maintenance of every debtor arrested on a copies as assisfaciendum, it shall and may be lawful for said sheriff to demand and receive the sum of one dollar and seventy-five cents per week, to be paid according to the provisions of an act, entitled, an act to provide for the support and maintenance of debtors actually confined in prison, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty.
