

**CHAP. 171.** any, to the register of wills for said county, whose duty it shall be to record the same.

**Compensation** **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners above named, or a majority of whom so attending, shall each be entitled to the sum of two dollars per diem, for each and every day they shall be engaged in the performance of the duties required of them by this act, to be paid by the orphans' court, out of any unappropriated money which may now or hereafter come into their hands for the purposes of education, and for the use of the upper district of said county, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

### CHAPTER 170.

**Passed Mar. 11, 1837.** *An act to divorce Mary Woods, of Frederick county, from her husband Michael Woods.*

**Divorce** **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Mary Woods, of Frederick county, be and she is hereby divorced from bed, board and mutual cohabitation with her husband Michael Woods.

**Claims annuled** **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That the said Michael Woods shall not be liable for any debt to be hereafter contracted by the said Mary Woods, nor be entitled to any property or estate she may now possess or hereafter acquire, nor shall she the said Mary Woods be entitled to any property or estate which he may hereafter acquire.

### CHAPTER 171.

**Passed Mar. 10, 1837.** *An act to divorce Benjamin W. Bacon, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Prudence Bacon.*

**Divorce** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Benjamin W. Bacon, of the city of Baltimore, be and he is hereby divorced from his wife Prudence Bacon, *a vinculo matrimonii.*
