CHAP. 173.

A supplement to an act to provide for the building a Passed Mar. 10 Bridge over the Western Run in Baltimore county, at the place therein mentioned, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, chapter fiftyeight.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assem-Preamble bly, by the petition of the commisoners mentioned in the first section of the act to which this is a supplement, and also by sundry taxable inhabitants of Baltimore county, that the sum of money authorised to be levied upon the assessable property of said county, for the purpose of building the bridge therein mentioned, is insufficient to build the same:-Therefore.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Levy authorised That the commissioners of Baltimore county, be and they are hereby authorised and required, at their next

annual levy, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, the sum of three hundred dollars, to be collected as other county charges are; and to pay the Psyment over same over to the commissioners authorised to build the bridge, as provided by the act to which this is a supplement, if in their judgment such additional sum be necessary for the building and completion of said bridge; and that the said bridge commissioners are hereby required to account to the commissioners of Baltimore Account requircounty, for the faithful application of the money here- ed by authorised to be applied to the building of said bridge. in the same manner as is provided by the act to which this is a supplement.

CHAPTER 173.

An act relating to Uhler's Alley, in the City of Baltimore. Passed Mar. 10. 1837.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be lawful for the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, at any time after the passage of this act, to provide by ordinance for the closing of so much of Uhler's alley, from its intersection with Charles street, westwardly, as may be agreed to by the owners of the 22
