

sealed with their corporate seals, and all deeds by them for the conveyance of any lands and tenements of the corporation which by the laws of the land ought to be acknowledged and recorded, shall be signed and sealed as aforesaid, and shall be acknowledged in due form by the vestry, or a majority of them, as such, in behalf of the corporation, and all acts and deeds of the said body corporate so authenticated, shall be valid and effectual in law. CHAP. 194.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted.* That the said corporation shall be capable of purchasing hereafter real and personal estate, not exceeding in value the sum of ten thousand dollars, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell the lot of ground, or any part thereof, and improvements thereon, now owned by said vestry, for the use and benefit of the Lutheran congregation in Cumberland, Allegany county, and with the proceeds to purchase another lot or lots of ground, and receive a conveyance in fee simple for the same, and to build a new church thereon. CHAPTER 194.

An act for the relief of negro George Hayman, of Somerset county. Passed Mar. 14,
1837.

WHEREAS, Cornelius R. Hayman, of Somerset county, on the seventh day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty, by a deed of manumission, manumitted and set free a certain negro George Hayman, of said county, that the said deed was not signed and sealed in the presence of a witness, as the act of Assembly directs, but was acknowledged before a justice of the peace of Somerset county, and was recorded in Liber G. H. number five, folio two hundred and thirty-one, one of the records of Somerset county court, and is in all respects good and valid, except the want of a witness as aforesaid; and whereas, the said Cornelius R. Hayman and negro George Hayman, by their separate petitions, pray a special act to make valid the said deed; Therefore, Preamble

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Deed confirmed
That the said deed of manumission from Cornelius R.
