pay

199, pine or cedar shingles, the whole to be completed in a workmanlike manner.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the money hereby required to be levied shall be made payable to the commissioners herein named, and shall be by them account-

ed for to the commissioners of their respective counties. and in case the said sum of eight hundred dollars shall not be fully and fairly expended in the erection of said bridge and filling in the abutments, that they shall return the surplus money to the said county commissioners in equal moieties to the said counties, to be by them

applied to the use of their respective counties. SEC. 3. And be it enacted. That the commissioners hereby appointed shall be entitled to a reasonable compensation for their services in attending to the erecting of said bridge, to be paid jointly by the respective

counties therein mentioned in equal proportions. SEC. 4. And be it enacted. That the assent of the president and directors of the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Company shall first be given in writing, on or before the first day of July next, to the commissioners herein mentioned, which assent shall be in conformity to the terms hereafter provided for, and shall be by said commissioners filed in the commissioners' office

of their respective counties. SEC. 5. And be it enacted. That the said turnpike Turnpike co, to company shall, when they turnpike such road laid out by said company up to said ford, pay to the commissioners of said counties the full amount of money expended in building and filling in said bridge.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted. That in the case of the death or refusal to act of the commissioners hereinbefore appointed, then and in that case the commissioners of said county wherein the vacancy or vacancies shall occur, shall at their next meeting fill such vacancy or vacancies as soon thereafter as may be convenient.
