SEC. 5. *And be it enacted, That immediately upon the decision of the arbitrators authorised to be chosen by the foregoing provisions of this act, if said decision should be favorable to said Alexander Donoho, the said levy court shall pay over to him the amount so decided to be due him, and if said sum so awarded, shall exceed the sum of two thousand dollars, the said levy court are authorised to levy said excess upon the assessable property of Somerset county, to be paid over to said Alexander Donoho.*

CHAPTER 214.

Passed Mar. 17, 1837. *An act authorising Henry Feete, surviving executor of Jacob Alexander, of Frederick county, deceased, to execute the last will and testament of the said deceased.*

Authority granted

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Henry Feete, surviving executor of Jacob Alexander, late of Frederick county, deceased, be and he is authorised and empowered, individually and alone, to execute the powers and trusts which were conferred upon and reposed in said Henry Feete and Jacob Alexander, as executors of the last will and testament of the said Jacob Alexander; provided nevertheless, that the said Henry Feete shall first give bond in such penalty as shall be prescribed by the orphans' court of Frederick county, and with such sureties as shall be approved by said court, well and faithfully to execute the trusts reposed in him by the said testament and last will, and by this act.
