CHAP. 218.

An act to grant a donation to the Manchester Academy, in Carroll County. Passed Mar. 18, 1837.

Preamble
WHEREAS, the several counties in this State, are now and for a long time have been in the receipt of certain sums of money from the State, for the benefit and support of academies therein respectively; and *whereas*, it is right and proper that Carroll county should participate in the liberal donations of the State for the benefit of education, — Therefore;

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the annual sum of three hundred dollars, to be paid by the Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland to the trustees of the Manchester Academy in Carroll county, or their order, for the benefit and use of said academy; *provided*, the trustees of said academy comply with the requisitions of the original act and its supplements, granting donations to the different colleges and academies in this State. \$300 annually payable to

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That so much of an act, entitled, a farther supplement to an act, entitled an act for the benefit of the trustees of Garrison Forrest Academy, and the Franklin Academy in Baltimore county, passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter one hundred and forty-six, as relates to granting to the Manchester United Academy or School, a donation of two hundred dollars, the same be, and is hereby repealed. CHAPTER 218.

An act to Incorporate the St. Martins Canal, and Navigation Company. Passed Mar. 18, 1837.

Preamble
WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Assembly by the petition of a number of subscribers, inhabitants of the upper part of Worcester county, that the navigation from St. Martin's Landing, and the Little Bay to Chincotigue Inlet, is obstructed by shoals, so that there is great danger in the navigation thereof,
