CHAPTER 219.

Passed Mar 18, 1837. *An act to repeal the second section of an act, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act, concerning the amendment of Judicial Proceedings, passed at December Session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter two hundred and seventy-six.*

Repeal

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the second section of an act, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act concerning the amendments of Judicial proceedings, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter two hundred and seventy-six, be, and the same is hereby repealed, Provided, that this law shall not be construed to effect any suit or action now pending, where the contract on which the said suit or action was founded, did not exist prior to the passage of the said second section; and provided also, that nothing in this act contained shall be construed to affect any action now pending, where all the parties to the same cause of action have been sued separately.

CHAPTER 220.

Passed Mar. 18, 1836. *An act to invest the State's share of the Surplus Revenue of the United States and for other purposes.*

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That of the money received, and to be received from the United States on account of this State's proportion of the surplus revenue of the United States, the sum of two hundred and seventy-four thousand, four hundred and fifty-one dollars, shall be, and the same is hereby set a part, and appropriated for the purpose of defraying the interest on the public debt already created, and other expenses of the government.*

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That the Treasurer for the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby authorised and directed to deposit so much of the aforesaid sum of two hundred and seventy-four thousand, four hundred and fifty-one dollars, as shall remain after payment of the temporary loan of last year, which he shall forthwith discharge, and reserving so much more as he shall find*
