### CHAPTER 233.

*A further supplement to an act, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty four, entitled, an act for the building of a Bridge over the Great Falls of Gunpowder, at Monkton Mills, in Baltimore County.* Passed May, 30,  
1837

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners of Baltimore county, be, and they are hereby authorised at their discretion to levy upon the assessable property of said county at such time as they shall deem expedient, any sum not exceeding five hundred dollars in addition to the amount specified in the act to which this is a further supplement, and the supplement thereto, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-five, chapter one hundred and fourteen, for building a Bridge over the Great Falls of Gunpowder, at or near Monkton Mills, in Baltimore county, and that the same shall be applied to the completion of said bridge and shall be accounted for, agreeably to the provisions of the act to which this is a further supplement.
