Company, and of the York and Maryland Line Rail CHAP. 236. Road Company, be, and they are hereby released and discharged, so far as may be necessary to enable the 80 far as said companies to borrow upon the security of the said roads, tolls, property or other effects, any sum or sums of money not exceeding six hundred thousand dollars. upon the terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned.

SEC. 2. And be it enucted, That the president and directors of the said Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Loan authoris-Road Company, be, and they are hereby authorised ed to complete and empowered to borrow, for the completion of the said Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road, and of the said York and Maryland Line Rail Road, and for providing suitable means and facilities for transportation thereon, such sums of money as they may require, not exceeding in amount six hundred thousand dollars: and to pledge and mortgage as a security for the repayment Pledge may be of the same, the roads, property and effects of the said given company, together with the tolls and revenue to be derived from the said road, free, clear and discharged from all claim which this State might make under the liens or mortgages executed to the State by the said Baltimore and Susquebanna Rail Road Company. and the said York and Maryland Line Rail Road Company, in pursuance of the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement; and to apply so much of the nett Proceeds applirevenue arising from said roads as may remain after the payment of interest to the State, to the payment of interest and redemption of the principal of the loan hereby authorised; provided, that nothing herein shall State claim to be so construed to affect or deprive the State of it's claim payment of interest, reserved under the act to which this is a supplement, and under the liens, mortgages and obligations executed in pursnance of the provisions thereof, to the payment of interest on its loan as therein specified; and provided and to the prinalso, that after the payment of the principal of the loan herein authorised, or the refusal of the person or persons, body corporate or politic, to whom the same may be owing, to receive the same when due, the State's claim for the principal sum of one million of dollars, shall be and remain as it was before the passage of this act; and provided also, that no contract Limi for a loan as aforesaid, shall be made or [entered into on any terms which will require the payment of the
