And be it enacted, That upon the final ratifi- Award of damacation of the commissioners' return by, the said county get courts, the clerks of the said county courts shall transmit to the levy court of their respective counties, a copy of the award of damages for their respective counties; that the damages awarded for so much of the road as lies in Montgomery county shall be paid by Montgomery county, and the damages awarded for so much of the road as lies in Frederick county shall be paid by Frederick county, and the expenses of the execution of this commission, other than the damages so awarded, shall he by said commissioners apportioned between said Apportioned counties, according to the length of road in said counties respectively, and said damages and expenses shall be levied and collected as other county charges are Levied and collevied and collected.

On raideation, cation of said return, the levy court of said counties dec. shall proceed to have opened, according to the provi-Shall open sions of said act of Asse mbly, the said road, and the same shall forever thereafter be deemed a public highway, and shall be thenceforth kept in repair by the Repair counties in which the same may be located, each county keeping in repair that part of said road which shall law within its limits.

CHAPTER 241.

An act to authorise the Commissioners of Cecil county to Passed Mar. 20 levy a sum of money for building a bridge over North-East creek, in said county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Lary directed of Maryland, That the commissioners of Cecil county \$900 be, and they are hereby authorised and required at their next ainual meeting, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding eight hundred dollars, to build a substantial bridge over North-East creek, after near Hurford's mill where the said creek crosses the road leading from the Rising Sun to the Buck Meeting House.
