CHAP. 36.

An act to change the terms of Prince George's County Court. Passed Jan. 30, 1837.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That from and after the April term of Prince George's county court, next succeeding the passage of this act, the terms of said court shall commence on the following days, set: on the second Monday in October and the first Monday in April, in each and every year, instead of the days now prescribed by law, and all writs original, mesne or judicial, and other process of said court, shall be returnable in conformity with the provisions of this act. Terms changed &c.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted.* That nothing in this act contained shall operate as a discontinuance of any cause in said court pending after the next April term thereof, but all such cases shall be continued over until the next succeeding term created by this act. Causes continued.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted.* That all laws inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal.

CHAPTER 36.

An act to Incorporate the Trustees of Central School in Frederick County. Passed Jan. 31; 1837.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That Benjamin Nelson, George Devilbiss, Henry Nelson, William Hobbs, and Anthony Kimmel, be and they are hereby appointed trustees of the Central School, in Frederick county, to act as such until the first Saturday in August next, and until the succeeding election of trustees as hereinafter mentioned, and the said trustees and their successors to be elected in the manner hereinafter mentioned, shall be, and they are hereby created, made and declared to be a body politic and corporate, by the name and style of the Trustees of Central School, of Frederick county, and by that name to have succession, and be able and capable at law and in equity, to sue and be sued, im- Trustees named, &c.
