CHAPTER 262.

An act to authorise James M. Selden, of Baltimore coun-Passed Mar. 15, ty, to bring into this State the several slaves therein 1837.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Permission That it shall and may be lawful for James M. Selden, of Baltimore county, to bring into this State, from the State of Virginia, the following named slaves for life, to wit: Tom, Eliza and her son Ferdinand; provided, that the said James M. Selden shall, in all respects, comply with the provisions of the act, entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to free negroes and slaves, passed at Docember session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter eighty-seven.
