Hacks defined, Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That every carriage, coach, or other vehicle, moved by horses, or other animal power, which shall be used for the conveyance of persons within the city of Baltimore, for hire or compensation, shall be deemed a Hackney Carriage within the meaning of

this act.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That every owner of a fackney carriage, who shall have obtained a licence therefor as required by the present or any future ordinances of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, shall be authorised and entitled, during the time in

shall be authorised and entitled, during the time in such licence specified, to charge, ask and receive as a compensation from every person using the same, the rates of fare and compensation, and hire, and no more to be fixed and determined by virtue of this act.
