The relation of master and slave in this State shall not be abolished, unless a bill to abolish the same, shall be passed by an unanimous vote of the members of each branch of the General Assembly, published for three months, &c. before a new election, and be confirmed by like unanimous vote at the next regular session—nor then without full compensation to the master, &c.
