

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That it shall be lawful for any person to have and maintain a sink box for the hunting and shooting of wild fowl on the Potomac River in Charles and Prince George's Counties.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That there shall be no license fee for having and maintaining a blind or sink box as provided in the preceding sections.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That any person violating any of the provisions of this Act shall, on conviction, be fined not less than ten nor more than twenty-five dollars for each and every offense.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1920.

CHAPTER 511.

AN ACT making the fiscal year of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and the State Roads Commission coincident with the fiscal year of the State.

Section 1. Re-enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That, beginning on October 1, 1920, the fiscal year of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and the State Roads Commission shall (be) coincident with the fiscal year of the State of Maryland; and thereafter the fiscal year of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and the State Roads Commission shall begin on October 1 and end on September 30 next.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and the State Roads Commission are hereby directed to make whatever changes may be necessary in their accounts and books so as to begin the fiscal year as provided in this Act. The reports of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and the State Roads Commission to the Governor or to any other authority to whom they are required by law to report, shall be made on or before October 31st in each year, beginning in the year 1922.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after June 1, 1920.
