CHAPTER 512.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 6 and 118 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, entitled, "Elections," by increasing the number of clerks and utility men to the Board of Election Supervisors of Baltimore City, increasing the compensation of certain election officials of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 6 and 118 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, entitled, "Elections," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Sec. 6. The Board of Supervisors of Elections of the several counties may have clerks, with the consent of the County Commissioners, for their respective counties, at such compensation as the said County Commissioners may fix. The Supervisors of Election of the City of Baltimore shall have a chief clerk at a salary of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) and assistant chief clerk at a salary of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), and a deputy clerk at a salary of two thousands two hundred and fifty dollars (\$2,250.00) and one assistant clerk at two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) and one deputy assistant clerk at a salary of eighteen hundred dollars (\$1.800.00), and four utility men at a salary of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) each, and one annex clerk at a salary of seventeen hundred dollars (\$1,700.00) per annum. The said clerks, and in the City of Baltimore, the chief clerk, assistant chief clerk, deputy clerk, assistant clerk, deputy assistant clerk, four utility men and one annex clerk shall be appointed by the respective boards of supervisors and shall be removable by them in their discretion. In Baltimore City. the chief clerk, assistant chief clerk, deputy clerk, assistant clerk and deputy assistant clerk, with the approval of the supervisors shall, from time to time, secure such temporary assistance as may be necessary for the proper transaction of the business of the office, but the compensation of such assistants to be paid by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, upon requisition by the said supervisors, shall not exceed the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars in any one year.

SEC. 118. The sheriffs in the several counties shall, respectively, be allowed the sum of twelve dollars (\$12.00) for each
