

## CHAPTER 529.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title, "Elections," sub-title, "Judges and Clerks of Election," to be known as Section 12-A, and to follow immediately after Section 12 of said Article, relating to the use of public buildings for polling places.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be added to Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title, "Elections," sub-title, "Judges and Clerks of Election," to be known as Section 12-A, to follow immediately after Section 12 of said Article, and to read as follows:

12-A. It shall be the duty of the Board of Supervisors of Elections of the City of Baltimore and of the several counties, to use, wherever possible and practicable, public buildings, such as school-houses, fire engine houses, etc., for registration and polling places. It shall be the duty of all public officials who have charge of such buildings to place them at the disposal of said Boards of Supervisors of Elections on the days of registration and elections when it does not interfere with the proper and regular use of such building or buildings.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the first day of June, 1920.
