CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Somerset County," sub-title "Fences," said new section to be known as Section 108B, and to follow immediately after Section 108A of said Article, providing that in Deal's Island every person shall be responsible for the safe-keeping of his livestock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Somerset County," sub-title "Fences," said new section to be known as Section 108B, to follow immediately after Section 108A of said Article, and to read as follows:

108B. On and after June 1, 1920, every person in Deal's Island, Somerset County, shall be answerable for his own livestock and responsible for its safe keeping, and said livestock shall not be allowed to trespass beyond the premises of its owner.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1920.

CHAPTER 91.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 33 of Article 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title "Banks and Trust Companies," sub-title "Savings Institutions," so as to provide for safe-deposit vaults and boxes for hire.
