Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 213.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 305 of the Acts of 1902 relating to the Orphans' Court of St. Mary's County, and to add a new section to Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," to be under sub-title "Orphans' Court," to be known as Section 81-A, to follow immediately after Section 81 of said Article, increasing the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Chapter 305 of the Acts of 1902, relating to the Orphans' Court of St. Mary's County, be and it is hereby repealed, and that a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "St. Mary's County," to be under sub-title "Orphans' Court," to be known as Section 81-A, to follow immediately after Section 81 of said Article, and to read as follows:

- 81-A. The Judges of the Orphans' Court of St. Mary's County shall receive six dollars each for every day's attendance upon the sessions of said Court.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from June 1, 1920.
