SEC. 2. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That for the purpose of carrying out the additional obligations which may be incurred under the provisions of the aforegoing section, the said County Commissioners of Washington County be, and they are hereby authorized, and directed, in their discretion, to levy and collect annually, in perpetuity on the assessable property of the county, a sum of money sufficient to meet the obligation to be incurred by the said County Commissioners of Washington County, under the provisions of the aforegoing section.

SEC. 3. And be it further enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That this Act shall take effect from June 1, 1920.

CHAPTER 221.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown, in Washington County, Maryland, in their discretion, to levy and collect, annually, in perpetuity, a sum of money in aid of the maintenance of the Washington County Free Library, and in addition to the sum now authorized to be levied and collected for that purpose.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown, in Washington County, Maryland, be and they are hereby authorized in their discretion, to enter into a contract with the Washington County Free Library whereby they shall contract to contribute, annually, in perpetuity, the sum of one thousand dollars for the care and maintenance of the said The Washington County Free Library, in addition to the amount heretofore authorized to be contributed.
