

necessary work of construction to be done, in accordance with the provisions hereinbefore set forth. Any tax so assessed as above provided in this section shall be payable to the County Treasurer as follows: in four equal annual installments, the first installment thereof to become due and payable within six months after the levy of said special tax as provided above, and each of the other said installments within one year after the preceding one shall have become due, each installment of said tax shall become a lien against said property owners and shall bear interest from the date of levy thereof at the rate of six per centum per annum until paid; or said tax may be paid in full without interest during the first installment period, and if any of said installments thereof be not paid within sixty days after the same shall have become due, the entire amount of said tax assessed to the person or persons, or corporations in default, with interest, shall thereupon become due and payable, and may be collected in the same manner provided in the Act for the collection of unpaid taxes. And all moneys so received by said county treasurer, shall, upon order of said Board of County Commissioners, be paid over to said treasurer of said village of Northwest Park, and the said Northwest Park Citizens' Committee shall apply said moneys to the purpose for which assessed.

#### CHAPTER 277.

AN ACT to authorize the State Roads Commission of Maryland to build an improved State Road from Mount Carmel, to run to a point where the present concrete road near Armiger, in the Third Election District of Anne Arundel County, ends; a distance of six miles, more or less.

#### CHAPTER 278.

AN ACT to add a new section to the Code of Public Local Laws for Anne Arundel County, title "Miscellaneous," to come in after Section 303B and to be designated as 303C, requiring all real property to be transferred on the County Assessment Books before deeds are received for recording.
