

clude said equipment in its invitation for sealed proposals as provided for in Section 4, or can purchase said equipment in any other way or manner as may by it be deemed best, the County Treasurer paying the warrants of the said Building Committee for equipment in the same manner and under the same terms as if the contract for equipment was awarded as set forth in Section 4.

SEC. 11. *And be it further enacted*, That the title to the building provided by this Act to be erected shall, when erected, be in the Board of Education of Caroline County as provided by Article 77, Section 24, of Volume 4 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SEC. 12. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 376.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Prince George's County to remodel and make an addition to the present school building at Seat Pleasant, in said county.

(Vetoed.)

CHAPTER 377.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Prince George's County to construct an improved road from the intersection of the District of Columbia line and the Suitland road, along the Suitland road to Suitland, thence by the New Cut road to the road leading from Red's Corner on a State road to the Marlboro Pike, and to authorize the said Commissioners to provide payment of the same by issuing county bonds, and directing that one-eighth of the cost of constructing said road shall be assessed against the property owners within a half-mile radius of said road.
