CHAP. 109.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners, before they proceed to act, shall take an oath, or affirmation, before some justice of the peace, that they will, without favour, partiality or prejudice, assess the damages sustained by the person through whose lands the said road may pass.

CHAP. CX.

A Supplement to the act to Incorporate a Company to make a Turnpike Road from near Ellicott's Lower Mills, towards George-Town, in the District of Columbia.

Passed Mar 4, 1829

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the president, managers and company, of the Columbia Turnpike road, incorporated by the act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from near Ellicott's Lower Mills towards George-Town in the District of Columbia, passed at November session one thousand eight hundred and nine, chapter one hundred and twenty-eight, be and they are hereby allowed the term of three years from the passage of this act to make and complete the turnpike road in said act mentioned, and that unless said turnpike road shall be made and completed within said term, the same shall revert to the state.

CHAP. CXL.

An Act to authorise the Levy Court of Frederick County to levy a sum of money for the purposes therein specified.

Passed Mar 6, 1829

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, the levy court of Frederick county are, and the same is hereby authorised, if they in their judgment deem it expedient, and that the public convenience requires the same, to levy a sum of money for the reasonable repair of the road leading from the town of Westminster, Taney-town, Emmitsburg, and from thence to Troup's tavern, and in all respects take such measures and proceeding as are had on
